Based on our review we have determined that the program and goal-setting methodology that you employed is consistent with the requirements set forth in 49 CFR Part 23. The goals, covering the period October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2017, are described as follows:

- Overall ACDBE goal for all (other than car rental) concession activities:
0.6% ACDBE Participation with 0% through race-conscious measures and 0.6 % through race-neutral measures
- Overall ACDBE goal for car rental concession activities:
0% ACDBE Participation
