A fifteen minute comment period was made available to the committee members and public guests. 10 people made comments during this timeframe. They were:





Outbound Capacity is down 148,283 seats over the next six months. This is a decrease of 19.6% yearover-year.



Noise Data: Total Runway Usage, Since Jan 1, 2020







Wiggins Runway Usage






Aircraft Tracking – Historical

- 1. Launch PWM Public Portal https://airport.vector-us.com/Public/PublicPortal.aspx?airportCode=KPWM
- 2. Live flight tracking is automatically displayed with 10 minute delay
- 3. Select Replay Tracks on top left corner of screen
- 4. Select a date range
- 5. Select a time range
- 6. Click button
- 7. User may fast forward or reverse
- 8. Stop button cancels playback
