## Welcome To Portland

Portland taxicabs are available outside of the baggage claim area. All services within the Greater Portland area shall be at the established meter rates. These areas are: Portland, South Portland, Scarborough, Cape Elizabeth, Westbrook and Falmouth.

## Meter Rate

- \$1.90 for the first 1/10<sup>th</sup> mile
- 30¢ for each additional 1/10<sup>th</sup> mile
- 40¢ a minute, or part thereafter, for waiting. Minimum fare of \$5.00 or meter rate, which ever is greater

## Flat Rates

Published rates for outside the metered zones are included in this brochure. These rates are based on normal driving conditions and must be agreed upon before the trip commences.

## Doubling Of Fares

There may be times when customers request to ride together. In this case, if both parties are going to the same destination, only one fare can be charged. This may be split between both parties. Different destinations will be considered as two separate fares.

## Smoking

Smoking is not permitted within the taxicab by either passenger or driver.

## Seatbelts

Maine State law requires all persons to wear seatbelts. Children up to 40 lbs. must be in a child safety seat, 40 to 80 lbs. or under age 8 must be in a booster seat, under age 11 must be in rear seat, if available.

## Refusal Of Passengers

A driver shall not refuse a passenger unless previously engaged or under conditions such as those described in the following paragraph:

### A driver is not required to transport:

- 1.) Any intoxicated persons
- 2.) Disorderly persons
- 3.) Passengers who are knowingly violating Federal, State or Local laws, or
- 4.) Passengers who the driver has just cause to fear bodily harm to him/her, or damage to the taxicab.

*A driver may not refuse or discriminate based on race, sex, sexual orientation, age, mobility or destination.*

## Other Ground Transportation

At a customer's request, limousines, livery vehicles, luxury cars, vans, etc. may be obtained by seeing the attendant at the Transportation Booth located outside of Baggage Claim.

## Credit Cards

Major credit cards are accepted. To pay by credit card, please see the attendant at the Transportation Booth. All transactions must be completed before trip commences.
